

WARDENS REPORT 2010

2010 has been a very busy one at St. Paul's, Kinderhook.

Our treasurer, Nancy Fagan, resigned and moved to Florida. Thank you John Phillips, for picking up the payroll portion of the Treasurers duties during the last half of the year. We officially welcomed Lisa Klepeis as our new Treasurer beginning January 1, 2011. She started transitioning into the position the last 2 months of 2010. Lisa is well qualified with a BS in accounting and 4 years' experience working for a large electrical contractor. We are reviewing and updating all our financial procedures with her help.

The search process for a new Rector has taken up a great deal of vestry time and is moving forward.

The McNary Center needed a new furnace (over \$13,000). It was installed over the summer. It should be paid in full within the next 3 months thanks to the monthly dinners put on by Julie Racquet and donations by parishioners

Our Diocesan Loan will be paid in full when we make a final payment July 2011.

Electrical and plumbing work has been completed in the Rectory. Thanks to Mark Kelly coordinating work parties, the Rectory will soon be ready for our new Rector.

Mark Moeske removed a dying tree in front of McNary and we thank him for that donation.
